

## **Certificate Course in Quran Recitation and Understanding**

A Certificate Course titled “Quran Recitation and Understanding” was organized by the Continuing Education and E-Learning Centre (CEEC) for students. The course was conducted by Mr. Muhammad Mohsin, Part-Time Lecturer at the Institute of Modern Languages (IML), University of Dhaka and concluded after 18 online sessions, which began on Saturday, February 7, 2026 with a duration of 4 weeks.

The course was thoughtfully arranged in alignment with the spirit of Ramadan 2026. It generated remarkable enthusiasm among students. A total of 137 students from Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Chad, Comoros, Gambia, Guinea, Ivory Coast, Niger, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Uganda, and Yemen registered and participated in the course.

The participating students learnt to identify and analyze different forms of Arabic letters, recite the 11 most recited Surahs of the holy Quran with proper tajweed and gained a foundational understanding of the holy Quranic Arabic grammar, comprehended the meaning and grammar of 6 Surahs used in Salah and understood 30% of commonly used Quranic vocabulary. In a brief, the participating students are now able to demonstrate proficiency in both Quranic recitation and fundamental comprehension. Certificates were awarded to the successful students upon completion of the course.
